Each numbered/roman statement inside a question is now printed on its own line for readability, followed by all four options with the correct one marked.

**Honest caveat:** A handful of questions (roughly 1–3% of the corpus) have minor parsing noise from an ambiguous numbering edge-case in the source PDF. Word-association, word-play, “Contemporary World”, and negative-cause/negative-impact rules all need human semantic judgement and are **NOT** included here as full-corpus tables — they stay illustrative-only, as flagged in the summary table below.

**Headline finding:** the small curated samples in the earlier PDF systematically overstated reliability. At full scale, most rules settle in the 50–65% range — genuinely useful as a tiebreaker, not a magic answer key. Two rules (D: pair-odd-count, and H/I: short-list-all-correct) actually collapse toward chance or worse at scale. Extreme-words (E) and mild-words (G) hold up best; the two new rules (M, N) land in the same solid 55–65% band as the rest.
